Program Overview

- Registration is open through February 21, no late registrations, no exceptions
- Match play start time can be as early as 7am and as late as 5pm
- All golf players must have their own golf clubs and accessories
- Junior League clinic schedules are generally posted mid-March. Match schedules generally posted mid-April
- Training League schedules generally posted mid-April

We Need You

Team Coordinator-1 per team

It is rather common to hear parents say, "I don't know anything about golf, I cannot help". Team Coordinators act as the head of communication, what parent doesn't already do this? Team coordinators will not have to give any golf instruction and will act as the liaison between the parents and the parish Golf Director.

- Must complete or have completed Protecting Gods Children seminar
- Arrange for the team to meet for practice on their own (players expense)
- Organize the team and match monitors for each week's matches
- Be present for each match or designate a parent
- Check in with Starter prior to the match
- Coordinator will be provided with a line up sheet and the teams scorecards prior to the match and after the match record the hold by hole scores for each golfer on the line up sheet

Match Monitor-2 parents per week

- Walk with a group of 4 golfers for 9 holes
- Responsible for maintaining pace of play and honesty within the group of golfers
- Assist the Team Coordinator in collecting the score cards and recording scores on the line up sheet
- If interested, please check the Coordinator box during registration
- We are very grateful to all who volunteer to help our golf and their parents

Who Can Play?

- All boys and girls, grades 2-8 are eligible for participation

Training League Grades 2-4

- No experience necessary and scoring is optional, non-competitive program for the beginner golfer
- (2)50-minute professional golf lessons
- (2) 9 hole rounds (maximum play time is 1 ½ hours per course play)
- Clinics and match play at Tower Tee

Junior League Grades 5-8

- No experience necessary and while there are matches and tournaments please keep in mind this is a recreational league for all skill levels
- Score keeping and golf etiquette are enforced
- All Junior League players and a parent are required to attend a Rules of Golf Etiquette seminar regardless of skill level. Lack of attendance means scores will not count toward tournament play. Location and dates can be found on the south central cyc website.
- CYC sports youth ID card is required for this league
- 3 50-minute professional golf lessons with the team. Held at Tower Tee
- Parish teams are comprised of 8 golfers by gender and grade

How do the matches and season work?

- If a team has fewer than 8 players, they will be combined with another parish team
- Maximum score for each hole is 4 over par with scores being kept for both individual and team
- Golfers must play with their assigned team for a minimum of three scheduled play dates in order to be eligible to qualify for individual district championships.
- At the conclusion for the six weeks of league play district championship tournament will be held for both individual and team qualifiers
- Top 8 individual golfers in league play qualify for the South Central Championship Tournament
- Top 4 finishers in the South Central District Championship Tournament will advance to the City-County Championship Tournament.

- All golfers must play at their grade level

Team and Individual Conflicts

- If the team has a conflict with a match due to a parish event the team will be moved to a different tee time
- Conflict due to another sport...accommodations may be made but not guaranteed
- Individual conflict...they may play at a different time however their score will not count for their team
- A player may only play 2 substitution rounds in a season

Uniforms and Equipment

- Uniform details will be sent to parents via email
- The Junior League uniform consists of a MQP polo shirt

2018 Fees

- Training League \$85
- Junior League \$150 (includes uniform shirt)
- \$25 additional fee for non-parishioners
